







The DCC discussed the request from Mr. Sayed Mohammad Ashraf Gardizy, an Afganistan National, for admission under Foreign National Scheme, to M. Tech programmes offered in the department. This application was forwarded by the Chairman, PG Admissions and received through Indian Council of Cultural Relations.


In this context, the DCC observed the following:

1. The candidate had completed a 3 year B.Sc degree programme in Computer Science from Kabul University. Upon scrutinizing the candidate's result transcript, it was observed that his undergraduate programme cannot be considered equivalent to the 4 year B.Tech programme which is the eligibility criteria for admission to M.Tech in NITC, as it is a three year programme after XII std.
2. Moreover, many of the important courses like Design and Analysis of Algorithms, and core courses like Theory of Computation, Compiler Design and Computer Organization have not been a part of his undergraduate curriculum.

Hence DCC decided not to recommend the request for his admission to the M. Tech programmes in the department.
