**Minutes of the DCC Meeting on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2018 (Wednesday)**

The meeting started at 3.30 pm. Dr. Saidalavi Kalady, HOD, CSED welcomed the members to the DCC meeting. The meeting discussed the recommendation of committee regarding probation and supplementary exams. The following suggestions were given by the DCC:

**1. Regarding Probation**

DCC feels that replacement of academic probation with the facility of temporary discontinuation is a good proposal, in principle, compared to the existing 'Academic Probation' which is having an adverse impact on the students psychologically and financially. Nevertheless, the DCC observed that the new proposal will have certain implementation difficulties in a practical sense, as it may result in having a lot of "non-registering /non-paying" students illegally staying in the campus itself which may ultimately vitiate the campus atmosphere.

DCC suggests that a better approach may be to fix a minimum credit limit at the end of each year of study such that those scoring below that may be asked to discontinue the program then and there itself. If discontinuation is not possible, the student may be allowed to continue with his batch-mates for 4 years. If there is a gap of 1 year there will be a stagnation for the student and this will not be healthy for the student as well as system.


















**2. Supplementary examinations**

DCC feels that supplementary examinations should be allowed for failed laboratory courses as well.

**3. Grade for Supplementary Exam**
