Minutes of DCC Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2015

1. DCC discussed the request from a 6<sup>th</sup> semester B.Tech student Mr. Giridhar Gangadharan Nair, seeking permission to register to the 7<sup>th</sup> semester despite having one backlog course in the second year.










Mr. Giridhar has failed in Mathematics III course of the third semester. He is currently repeating the Mathematics IV course of the fourth semester along with the 6<sup>th</sup> semester courses. He has cleared all other courses up to and including the 5<sup>th</sup> semester. As per the Institute regulations, one cannot register to the 7<sup>th</sup> semester without clearing all the courses in the first two years. Accordingly, Mr. Giridhar has to go on academic probation during the next academic year for repeating one course (OR two if he happen to fail in the currently undergoing Maths IV course). In such a case, he will have only one course to do in the entire one year period (OR two courses, one in each semester, if he happen to fail in Maths IV).

The DCC discussed the above case in detail and observed that there are a few repeater students in 2012 admission batch who are yet to clear Maths III or/and Maths IV courses which will make them ineligible to register to the seventh semester.. These students will have to go on probation for a year for just one (OR two) subject(s).

DCC observed that 2012 batch students do not have 'R' grade which is there from 2013 admission batch onwards. Moreover, the senate had given certain relaxations to their senior batch students (up to 2011 admission students) earlier, under similar circumstances. It so happens that just one batch of students, the 2012 admission batch, alone is being left out with no relaxations or provision for 'R' grade. Hence the DCC resolved to recommend the above request for consideration by the BOAC/ Senate.

2. DCC discussed the recommendations on the conduct of Supplementary Examination prepared by Dr.Priya Chandran, Professor, CSED, as entrusted by the DCC earlier. The DCC resolved to forward the recommendations the Dean (Academic).
