Dr. Manjanna B and Dr. Chandramani Chaudhary then briefly introduced themselves, providing some of their background information to the DCC members. The new student members Jaybharat Vora (MTech), Sankhanil Nayek (MCA), Pattipati Manaswi (BTech) also introduced themselves and they were also welcomed by the chairperson to the DCC.

Agenda Item 3: Ratification of the recommendations for Adjunct faculty & Professor of Practice

DCC ratified the following recommendation given by CSED to Centre for Industry Institutional Relations of the NITC on Adjunct Faculty and Professor of Practice appointment:

For the ongoing semester (Monsoon Semester 2023-24), we strongly recommend the application of Prof. Sunil Chandran Leela, Professor IISc, for the post of Adjunct faculty. As the semester has already started, we won't be able to consider the applications for the post of Professor of Practice in this semester (Monsoon Semester 2023-24). However, for the next semester (Winter Semester 2023-24), we will plan the courses beforehand and the applications of Professor of Practice (Mr. Manoj N Palat & Mr. Narayana Pai) will be considered.

Agenda Item 4: Filling up of vacant seats of Self sponsored/ Self financing seats of M Tech

The DCC resolved to conduct a written test for applicants for a spot admission round, and all candidates who qualify the written test may be considered in the order of their total test score for admission to the vacant seats of M.Tech self-sponsored category in the spot round of admission. The syllabus for the test shall be the same as that of the previous round of admission conducted on 5th July 2023 .

Agenda Item 5: Regarding the internship of second year M. Tech students

Mr Jay Bharat Vora, MTech student representative, presented a request (Annexure I) for granting permission for MTech students to participate in placement drives organized by companies offering internships with subsequent full-time job offers. In addition to making this request, he also voiced the concerns of second-year MTech students regarding the significant drop in placement rates due to the ongoing recession compared to the previous year's statistics at the same time.

After an extensive deliberation, the DCC reached a consensus on the following recommendations:

For the academic year 2023-24, MTech students will be granted the opportunity to engage with companies that provide internships accompanied by full-time job offers, under the stipulated conditions:

1. Companies must commit to providing both an internship and a full-time job.
2. The endorsement of the above arrangement by NITC's Centre for Career Development (CCD) is mandatory.
3. The internship permitted will be for the Winter semester 2023-24



Agenda Item 6: M Tech internship policy for Self-sponsored / Self financing students

The DCC recommended permitting self-sponsored/self-financing candidates of MTech CS/IS/AI-DA to undertake internships in the industry during their second year, as there are no teaching assistant (TA) duties, owing to the unavailability of an institute stipend for these candidates.

Agenda Item 7: Equivalent Courses - B.Tech CSE

Dr. Vinod Pathari, the UG Program Coordinator, informed the DCC members about the mapping of equivalent courses in the new curriculum for the courses in the old curriculum. He suggested that the faculty advisors (FAs) take note of this mapping while registering higher semester students for their first-year courses.

Sub: Allowing to Appear in Placements for Companies that Offer Internship + FTE(Full Time Employment)

Sir/Madam,

As the placement sessions are going on, however, due to the ongoing recession, the intake has been reduced compared to last year. Also, because of this, companies are requiring mandatory pre-placement internships along with FTE roles, which we are not allowed to be in as per the current department policy.

As we had discussed earlier with HoD, the respective Program Coordinators, and the Faculty Placement Representative (Dr T.A Sumesh Sir) regarding this, we have requested to appear in companies that offer pre-placement Internships along with Full Time Employment (FTE).

After the meeting, we reached the following conclusion:

- The CCD must provide a letter to the department ensuring that the companies that offer internship + FTE will make sure that the candidate will be absorbed into the company after his/her internship.
- Along with this, the students are willing to put in the effort to manage both the internship as well as their M.Tech project simultaneously, facilitating the final evaluation for the department.

After discussing with the class, we've concluded that the students are willing to put in the effort to manage both their internship as well as their final year project. So, we kindly request you to take the necessary actions to ensure that the students can sit for such companies.
