Minutes of the DCC Meeting on 24th April 2017 (Monday)

Venue: CSE 202

Time: 4.00 pm

The meeting started at 4.00 pm. Dr. Saidalavy Kaladi, HOD, CSED welcomed the members to the DCC meeting. The Agenda of the meeting was to discuss the new MCA and B.Tech curriculum to be proposed

Dr. Murali Krishnan presented the curriculum and explained the important changes in the curriculum. DCC discussed the provision in the curriculum for the student to do final semester project outside the college. DCC recommends that student should be given the flexibility to do their final semester (S8) project in the industry if they receive a good opportunity. However clear guidelines have to be developed in the department on how such requests will be handled.

It was proposed that a CGPA cut off to be used as a criteria for permitting students to do project outside. The students with required CGPA in S4 will be allowed to do selective overloading of S8 electives in S5 and S6 and finish the S8 with industry project and term paper. The detailed policy to be decided in future DCC.

DCC observed that MCA curriculum included UG level course work and PG level project requirements. This was done as the industry requires MCA students to take the same courses as B.Tech students for considering them for placement along with them. Though MCA is a PG level course they have not covered the course work in their bachelors program. Hence MCA curriculum is designed with coursework similar to B.Tech and project requirement as in PG level.

DCC reviewed and accepted the draft version of curriculum presented by Dr. Murali Krishnan.
