DCC considered the proposal from SAC for making changes in the conduct of _____/assignment/tutorials. The opinion of the DCC with regard to each of the items in the proposal is listed below

1: Duration of Exam

DCC recommends modifying the time duration for mid semester exam in proportion to the weightage, up to a maximum of 3 hours as SAC has suggested.

2. Allocation of percentage for Assignment, Presentation, Tutorials etc-

Department feels that as there are different variety of courses this must be left to the decision of course faculty. Presentations are not practical in large classes and plagiarism can't be detected effectively in take home exams/assignments. However instead of one quiz it can be mandated that two quizzes are conducted so that student has more chances.

3. Weightage of Midterm Exam.

DCC recommends that Mid semester weightage may be limited to 30% and final exam weightage may be limited to 50% so that at least 20% internal assessment component is present for the course as recommended by SAC

4. Assignment and Interim Evaluation

DCC suggests that issuing of assignments should be done at least two weeks before the end semester examination.
