Agenda Item 5: Request to conduct contact course for Compiler Design from two B20 students

Dr. Sumesh T.A. presented requests from two B20CS students, Kulhati Hemanth (B200860CS) (Annexure III) and Prathamesh Shirang Waydande (B200857CS) (Annexure IV), seeking a contact course for Compiler Design (CS3005D).

For Kulhati Hemanth (B200860CS), Compiler Design is the only pending course, and it is a core course scheduled to be offered in Winter 2024-25. However, the student has a history of malpractice in the ReX exam for Compiler Design. According to the ordinances and regulations for B20CS students, there is no provision for contact courses. Due to these reasons, the DCC does not recommend his request for a contact course. However, if there is a similar request from other departments that receives a favorable decision from the authorities, it could be extended to this student as well.

In the case of Prathamesh Shirang Waydande (B200857CS), he has seven pending courses. Therefore, his request cannot be considered as a request for a contact course. Consequently, the DCC does not recommend his request.

Agenda Item 6: Need for dedicated high computing server for B.Tech students and revamping Athena server

Mohammad Saad RafceQ, the B.Tech representative, presented a request on behalf of the current final-year B.Tech students for the allocation of a GPU server or system. This resource would greatly benefit those working on Deep Learning projects, as many require a GPU server for their final year work. Additionally, he informed the DCC about the underutilized space on the Athena server in SSL and proposed that it be revamped to store datasets and allocate space to students, reducing their reliance on Google Drive.




